Dear Classmate:

Greetings! We are sending this email to everyone registered on classmates.com as well as all of those for whom we have email addresses. Please forgive us if you receive it twice but there is no way of knowing what the actual email addresses are on classmates.com. Our goal is to get correct emails for everyone on our class database for future communication.

As many of you may know, we have had a class web site for the past two years – www.pchs1970.org. We recently made some updates to it including an option to search our database for classmates by high school last name or state of residence. We hope you enjoy keeping up with your classmates via the web site and that you will continue to keep us updated with news about yourself or another classmate. If we do not have correct information for you on the web site, please provide it on the update form provided on the Class Directory page.

With our 35-year reunion (yikes!!) looming on the horizon in 2005, we're anxious to reach as many classmates as possible and collect complete address/email information over the next year or two. Certainly modern technology helps us in this effort. Along with updating our database, we are proposing that we create a non-profit organization - **PCHS Class of 1970 Alumni Association** - to collect funds to support our web site as well as ongoing reunion planning and communication.

In order to apply for non-profit status with the IRS, which will also make us tax-exempt, we are required to provide an "organizing instrument." Below is a resolution we are presenting to you, our classmates, for your review. If you do not support this resolution and our attempt to organize an association, please reply accordingly. If we do not hear from an overwhelming majority by March 15, we will proceed with the IRS application.

"Be it resolved, the graduates of the 1970 class of Putnam City High School, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, do hereby establish the **PCHS Class of 1970 Alumni Association** with the intent and sole purpose of providing the membership access to and information on fellow classmates and providing coordination and planning services for reunions at such times as deemed appropriate by the membership.

Funds collected to support the Association shall be used solely to defray those expenses incurred by the Association in carrying out its purpose."

To date the cost of the development and ongoing operation of the class website has been generously donated by some of our classmates. Going forward, however, considering the continued expenses for the website and the incremental expenses associated with the initial planning of class communications and reunions, it would seem both unfair and

inappropriate for those folks to continue to bear that burden alone. As an alternative, we are asking those who can to donate a minimum of **\$10/year** toward the support of this organization, our web site and reunion planning. A separate checking account will be established and all income and expenses will be reported to you on a regular basis.
